Registration

All video presenters must register and pay the applicable registration fees to remain in the program. Presenters who fail to pay registration fees risk being removed from the program at the discretion of the Program Committee. There is no reduced registration fee for presenters. The first author of each video, who is the presenter, will be given a ‘program participant’ ribbon that he/she can attach to the delegate badge to recognize his/her participation in the submitted program.
